Atlantic City News and Rumors Control

- The Borgata's "Premier" Night Club closing on Aug. 31, following nearly a 10- year run.
- AC's last-minute Airshow was on July 15-16th, 2025.
- According to Yogonet, A.C. casinos saw a significant drop in profits of more than 9%.
- MGM Resort's President and CEO landed a strong start of the new Asian gaming space in the Borgata.
- National Consumer group endorses N.J. bill to ban Mobile Sports betting ads.
- FanDuel picks up a few percentage points in market share even as the total market remains flat in Atlantic City.
- Las Vegas based Allegiant Airlines is expanding service to include Atlantic City.
- Coury Hospitality opens "The Seahaus Hotel", on the Atlantic City boardwalk.
- Schultz-Hill foundation continues to flourish in Atlantic County.

Las Vegas and Other Casino News and Rumor Control

- L.V. Grand Prix extended through 2027 via a \$20 Million LV CVA Sponsorship Deal.
- The Golden Gate Hotel and Casino, (Downtown LV), removing all live dealer games by August 2025.
- L.V. Man wins \$442K @ The South Point while playing Pai Gow Poker.
- A fire burned the Sahara's rooftop from construction debris. No damage, no injuries reported.
- The L.V. Convention & Visitors Authority reported a 11.3% decrease in travelers in June 2025. Hotel occupancy rates are down 8.1%. Nevada gaming revenues saw a slight drop of 3.8% in May.
- Billionaire Tilman Fertitta will not pursue his LV strip project.
- Resort's World temporarily waiving their resorts fees through September of 2025.
- Fontainebleau L.V. has reportedly laid off an undisclosed number of table game dealers. Local media reports that number might be as high as 60%, according to Yogonet.
- Maverick Gaming, which owns 5 Nevada casinos, files for Bankruptcy.
- Whiskey Pete's remains closed today. And Yes, will remain closed permanently.
- Ellis Island is currently undergoing a large- scale renovation project.
- WingBowl is making a triumphant comeback in Las Vegas. WingBowl will be hosted for the first time by The Plaza Hotel and Casino on February 7th, 2026.
- The Downtown Grand Casino has stopped paying their vendor's invoices secondary to their decreased cash flow.
- The L.V. Sphere continues to be a financial success.
- L.V. Casino equipment maker "Light & Wonder" will be delisted on the Nasdaq stock exchange.
- WrestleMania 42 will be coming to Las Vegas in 2026.
- The Athletics (A's), held their groundbreaking ceremony on June 23rd, on their new stadium.
- L.V. Tourism officials blame the new tariffs for fewer visitors this year, as others say the Las Vegas's magic is gone.
- Holstein's Burger Restaurant from the Cosmopolitan Hotel & Casino, opens a location downtown.
- L.V. Sphere sells over 120,000K tickets to the Wizard of Oz.
- Via Via Food Hall, opens in the Venetian, on the Casino Floor.
- North Carolina leaders discuss plans for 4 new casinos.
- Snoqualmie Casino & Hotel launches luxury Tower, Spa, and new amenities.
- Pennsylvania Senate approves Bill to cut minimum casino slot machines count.
- New York Sportsbook maintains strong July with third month above 11% hold.
- Firelake Casino & Hotel debut brings in new era for the Citizen Potawatomi Nation.
- Peoria presses Boyd Gaming " to build a casino", in the city, or sell the license.
